

Bronze DVIDA patterns not eligible at NDCA events:

ChaCha

- Shadow positions – listed as half moon in Silver steplist
- Cross-Body PullBack – listed as PushAway action in Silver steplist
- Crossover Flick to Side break – basically Aida or Paseo also with optional timing of &2. Both are only permissible in Silver and up

Rumba

- Spot Turn combination – Second part is Forward spot turn which is Silver pattern

Bolero

- Romantic Sways – has a Fencing line inside of it, which is a Silver figure
- Spot turn combination – kind of has Forward spot turn in it, but if done with less rotation to the left, can pass as a crossbody lead.
- Hip twist and spin – entire figure should be moved to silver, as has hip twist, which is silver as well as double underarm turn for lady with timing of Q&Q& - only allowed in Silver

Mambo

- Promenade swivel and close- has a Scallop ending at the end, which is a Silver figure
- Rueda Basic – has Aida (Paseo) inside of it, which is Silver
- Cross Body Lead with Inside turn – contains 3step Pivot exit, which is only permissible in Silver
- Mambo twist – contains Advanced Hip twist only allowed in Silver
- Forward spot turn – the entire pattern consists of Silver patterns – Forward Spot turn, Surprise break and hip twist
- Crossover Breaks and Pull Back – the pull back portion of the pattern is not allowed in bronze, however, if only crossover breaks and swivels are kept, step will be OK for Bronze
